

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Burdette.

Mayor Burdette asked the City Clerk to explain the problem on the rates adopted on April 7, 1975. After full examination of the proposed revised rates there seems to be quite a disparity in the commercial, commercial all-electric and industrial rates. The Clerk recommended that a straight 29% sur charge be charged to each commercial, commercial all-electric and industrial customer for the months of April until correct individual formulas could be calculated for these customers. She further recommended that the residential and school and etc. electric rates, the sewer and water rates remain as adopted on April 7, 1975.

The Clerk stressed the Council's desire to hold the rates as low as possible in view of the 32.2% average increase to the City on power purchased from the wholesaler.

Ald. Cox made the motion to amend the April 7, 1975, motion as recommended by the Clerk, 2nd by Ald. Collins and approved.
