City Council met in a special session at the city hall with the following members present: Mayor Frank M. Dickinson, Aldermen Woods, King, and David. Alderman Lewis being absent due to reserve training requirements.

Mayor Dickinson called the meeting for the purpose of discussing a new power contract with the Georgia Power Company. Mr. Howard Harrison, Mr. Wesley Johnson, and Mr. Bob Sherrill of the Georgia Power Company were present at the meeting along with attorney Harry Lawrence representing the City of Calhoun. After discussion an agreement was reached between the two parties that would allow the City of Calhoun to serve the new Fletcher Brothers plant now being built outside the city limits of the City of Calhoun on the Mauldin Road. Also the city agreed to not furnish any additional power outside the city limits where the Georgia Power Company could serve. Also the Georgia Power Company reserved the right to serve any customer inside the city limits with a 100 Horsepower connected load. After additional discussion Alderman King made a motion that Mayor Dickinson sign the contract that called for a period of five years. This motion was seconded by Alderman Woods was voted on and passed.

There being no other business the meeting was adjourned.
