

Call to order by Mayor Burdette.

Mayor Burdette asked for the report from the committee assigned to determine a sealed bid price for the Post Office Building and property. The price, \$51,999.00, was stated and approved and the City Clerk was authorized to send the bid to the real estate division of the Postal Department.

After lengthy discussion, a motion was made by Ald. Cox to adopt the following resolution and to authorize the preparation of a similar amendment to the present liquor ordinance for the June 9, 1975, council meeting, 2nd by Ald. Lewis and approved.

Be it resolved that no one person may have any interest whatsoever in both a liquor and beer license. However, this will not prohibit a party from having both a wine and beer or a liquor and wine license excluding bona fide fraternal organizations.

Be it further resolved that it is the general policy of the Council to issue beer, wine or liquor license only to package stores, liquor stores and restaurants, excluding bona fide fraternal organizations.

Motion to adjourn by Ald. Collins, 2nd by Ald. Lewis and approved.
