


SEPTEMBER 26, 1986 - 9:45 A.M., SPECIAL CALLED COUNCIL MEETING at CITY
COURTROOM ON PIEDMONT STREET

1. Mayor Meadows called the meeting to order.
2. Ald. Oldfield made a motion to approve the Dept. of Transportation contracts for paving of the High School and Eastside and to authorize Mayor Meadows to sign the contract, 2nd by Ald. Bond with Ald. McEntire and Mayor Pro-Tem King voting affirmatively, motion carried.
3. The Council reconsidered the sewer tap request for the property south of Duffey's Motel North on U.S. Highway 41 North. Mr. Smith was present and explained his request. Mr. Smith also reviewed the prior sewer tap for property across Highway 41 some years earlier which still shows a balance outstanding according to City records. Following a lengthy discussion, Ald. Bond made a motion to deny the tap since the property is in the County, and this is contrary to current City policy; the outstanding balance on the previous tap should be settled by Mr. Smith's attorney and the City's attorney, 2nd by Mayor Pro-Tem King with Ald. Oldfield and Ald. McEntire voting affirmatively, motion carried.
4. Mayor Meadows stated the Council needed to consider a variance request by Paul J. and Mary S. Green to build within 2 ft. of the adjoining property line. The request being approved by the adjoining property owner, Ms. Beulah Bagley. Mayor Meadows stated the matter would be subject to official consideration on October 13, 1986.
5. Mayor Pro-Tem King made a motion to adjourn, 2nd by Ald. Oldfield with Ald. McEntire and Ald. Bond voting affirmatively, motion carried.
