





1. Mayor Meadows called the meeting to order.
2. Councilman Bond made a motion for the City to install approximately 800 ft. of 6" reinforced concrete drain tile, 1000 ft. of 54" metal drain tile with Carriage Carpets to reimburse 100% for the material cost, and 25% for installation with the City paying 75% of installation in lieu of a sewer easement which will provide the City with a line for future growth north of Carriage. The motion also approved installation of 800 ft. of 12" sewer line at approximately \$25,275.00 which must be installed during Carriage's construction phase. Motion was second by Mayor Pro-Tem King with Councilman Oldfield and Councilman McEntire voting affirmatively, motion carried.
3. Following a lengthy discussion of the price to set for sewer connection fees for Belwood Road, with an understanding that line extension for 1000 ft. to 1200 ft. would be approximately \$35,000.00 and the City desires to recoup cost, Councilman McEntire made a motion to set the fee at \$5,000.00 plus the sewer connection fee in force for City or County residency, for retail business, 2nd by Mayor Pro-Tem King with Councilman Bond and Councilman Oldfield voting affirmatively, motion carried.
3. Meeting adjourned.
