After discussing the finances of the city it was agreed to borrow \$20,000. from the Calhoun National Bank. Resolution attached.

The council agreed to purchase approximately 1.3 acres from Mr. C.L. Moss said land being located near the present filter plant. The cost of the land being \$200.00.
