City Council met in call session with all members being present.


Mayor Edwards called the meeting to order.

Mayor Edwards called the meeting for the purpose of discussing the money for the new armory to be constructed in the City of Calhoun. Under the new contract with the Commissioner of Gordon County the City of Calhoun was to furnish the City's and County's pro rata share of the cost of the new armory. The City-County share was \$ 16,671.24. After discussion Alderman Norton made a motion that the above amount be borrowed from the Calhoun National Bank for a period of six months(Resolution Attached). This motion received a second from alderman Dickinson voted on and passed.

Alderman Dickinson made a motion that all city employees be given 6 days sick leave per year and one week vacation with pay. This motion received a second from Alderman Woods voted on and passed.

There being no other business the meeting was adjourned.
