1. Chairman Ellis Hite welcomed visitors and Engineers, and related to the need for planning for future Landfill Sites for residential and industrial waste.
2. Mayor Meadows reviewed the need for immediate action in proper planning and site selection since the current sites have very short life remaining.
3. First Engineer - Kim Ives, GA. Landfill Services, Graduate of Georgia Tech in 1972 - BS Industrial Engineering. Has had ten years experience with State - EPD. His basic concept is to sale as much recoverable waste as possible, thereby adding life to existing Landfill or to future sites.
4. Hensley - Schmidt, Inc. - Wynne Grubbs - Michael Mathews Project Manager. Company in business for 44 years with 160 employees, with an office in Atlanta. Displayed a chart outlining their procedure - Three Phases - (1) Site Assessment, (2) Design, (3) construction. Would also review existing sites for possible life remaining. Their fee system is cost plus, with an upper limit.
5. Moreland, Altobelli, Asso. Inc. - Bill Williams - Reviewed background of Company briefly. Stated the steps, location of site, assessment, evaluation, site acquisition, surveying, and mapping. Letter of Acceptance, Public Advisory, Preliminary Review, Design, and Operational Planning, Permitting. The rates are based on hourly fees.
6. Tribble and Richardson, Inc. - Rhea Converse, Steve Harbin - Firm in business for 19 years, employees 145 people, two offices, Macon and Atlanta. Project Manager to be a Senior Level Engineer. Firm has completed 150 projects in State of Georgia. Briefly reviewed Subtitle D of EPD regulations on solid waste. Expressed possibility of adding bar material and expanding existing site vertically rather than a new site. Fee Structure - Lump Sum Fee.
7. Sweitzer and Peoples, Inc. - John Sweitzer, Bob Peoples - Atlanta Company, 15 Employees. Both have Environmental Masters Degrees. Briefly reviewed their present work with City of Calhoun, Fairmount, and Gordon County. Reviewed their knowledge of Landfill Engineering and Management. Work will be billed on an hourly basis.
