



1. Mayor Meadows called the meeting to order; apologized for the overrun of Municipal Court.
2. Mr. Jack Pyburn of Jaeger/Pyburn, Inc. of Gainesville gave a thirty minute presentation. Mr. Pyburn presented a slide program of several projects the company had underway or had completed. He stated his associate, Dale Jaeger, had reviewed the depot and he gauged the cost per square foot for the project to be \$45.00 to \$75.00.
3. Mr. Gregory Chupp of Chupp Associates of Atlanta reviewed his background and distributed individual packets with listed past clients and references. Mr. Chupp stated he had visited the site twice and gave an estimate of cost (total - \$400,000.00) for renovation. He presented a preliminary sketch of the block and depot.
