1. Commission Chairman Hite opened the meeting.
2. Commissioner Monanaro stated Santek had given a proposal for labor for the City/County landfill on Harris-Beamer Road. He stated the proposal included closing the current industrial site and using the sanitary site for all refuse. The industrial site could be officially closed. The Santek group stated with their method of dirt handling they projected a two year life on the remainder of the landfill. This was confirmed by engineering firm Hensley-Schmidt. The offer was for \$488,917.00 annually with County furnishing all equipment, but they would maintain and service.

The County provided their projection for local operation including the use of scales, but could not project a two year life.

The County deemed the proposal of Santek too high and was prepared to offer an amendment, but wished to discuss with the City first. Following discussion, the City stated they would recommend preceding with the proposed amendment to Santek. The Council asked that they be kept informed of the progress.

The group consensus was to name the new landfill site Gordon County Landfill.

Meeting adjourned at 3:45 P.M.
