
1. Mayor Meadows called the meeting to order.
2. Mayor Meadows stated the purpose of the meeting was to adopt rules and regulations regarding the landfill.
3. Following discussion, Mayor Pro-Tem King made a motion to enact the following emergency rules of operation regarding waste to be dumped at the landfill:
 1. Only residential, industrial and commercial waste generated in Gordon County, GA is permitted to be disposed of at a Gordon County landfill or part of the landfill owned by the City of Calhoun.
 2. Sludge Waste - It is the intention of Gordon County and City of Calhoun to accept only sludge wastes which have been approved by the Department of Environmental Protection Division and deemed appropriate by the County and City.
 3. No hazardous waste will be accepted. No person shall deposit or attempt to deposit hazardous waste on Gordon County/City of Calhoun landfill property. No material other than residential, commercial and industrial waste that has been approved by EPD and Gordon County/City of Calhoun may be deposited at the landfill.
 4. No bio-medical waste, as defined by the EPD (391-3-4-15) will be accepted at any Gordon County or portion of landfill operated by the City of Calhoun. No person shall deposit or attempt to deposit such waste on Gordon County/City of Calhoun landfill property.
 5. No mixed loads as defined in the Gordon County Ordinance, page three, item (X), effective 7-1-90 will be accepted at any Gordon County/City of Calhoun landfill. No person shall deposit or attempt to deposit mixed loads on Gordon County landfill property or compactor site or City of Calhoun landfill.
 6. No waste originating outside the limits of Gordon County shall be accepted at any Gordon County landfill or compactor site or portion of landfill operated by the City of Calhoun. No person shall deposit or attempt to deposit at any Gordon County landfill or compactor site or portion of landfill operated by the City of Calhoun any waste originating outside the limits of Gordon County.

7. Construction and demolition waste which originates in Gordon County will be accepted.

These rules will be enforced administratively until such time an ordinance to coincide with the Gordon County ordinance with a \$500.00 fine for violations to be enforced by a County officer can be adopted. At this time anyone in violation of these rules will be turned away and not allowed to dump, 2nd by Councilman Oldfield with Councilman Shelton voting affirmatively, motion carried.

4. Motion to adjourn made by Councilman Oldfield, 2nd by Mayor Pro-Tem King with Councilman Shelton voting affirmatively, motion carried.
