ALL FEES must accompany a completed application along with a set of stamped plans upon submittal.

Your submittal to the Calhoun Fire Department is for the review and inspection of all fire protection and handicap requirements outlined in the City of Calhoun Code of Ordinance, the International Fire Code, National Fire Protection Agency (NFPA) with particular attention to the Life Safety Code (NFPA 101), the Georgia Accessibility Code (120-3-20), and all Georgia amendments.

INSPECTION FEES:

- All commercial and industrial buildings up to 25,000 square feet: \$250.00
- All buildings 25,001 square feet or more shall pay .01 cent per square foot of building. (example: 50,000 square feet = \$500.00)

IFC 510 Compliance Acknowledgement: Before a Fire Safety Codes Release (Certificate of Occupancy) is issued, compliance with International Fire Code Section 510 is required by means of an Emergency Responder Radio Coverage System (ERRCS) installed, tested, and accepted OR through field testing by an FCC licensed radio contractor to verify that an ERRCS is not warranted. A critical element to compliance with this standard is preliminary testing once the building is dried-in.

Knox Key Box Requirements

To provide emergency responders access to buildings or occupancies at any time of night or day, the City of Calhoun Fire Department requires (per IFC 506) Knox key boxes to be installed in commercial and industrial buildings 3,000 square feet or larger. Fire Marshall must approve location.
